Q: Is your life marked by Joy?

Joy Defined:

Joy is “*gladness experienced*”, the result of a mindset of *certain hope* acting out in humility and gentleness by putting others first and considering their needs more important than my own. When we pray for joy, God gives us the opportunity to to be exceedingly joyful in that He gives us the opportunity to live for others.



Jesus described Himself once:

Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me,

For My yoke is comfortable, and My burden is light.”

Put others **FIRST!**


Bow low in prayer, stay there in humility.

# What does it look like?

Martin Lloyd-Jones, England, shortly after WWII:

*“How often during that last war were we told of the extraordinary scenes in air-raid shelters; how different people belonging to different classes, there, in the common need to shelter from the bombs and death, forgot all the differences between them and became one. This was because in the common interest they forgot their divisions and distinctions.”*

Not in the roar of the crowd,  
Nor the glare of the spotlights,  
Nor the applause at your accomplishments;  
Those may bring temporary happiness,  
but typically not JOY.



Joy is found on that dusty road to  
Golgotha, following the Savior who gave  
His all for you.

He didn't have to be there; neither do you.
