

## Majesty!

1. Habakkuk experienced the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of GOD (Hab. 3:1-15)

(cf. 3:18-19 with 2 Cor. 12:9-10)

**Application:** If you do not internalize these truths, they just sit ‘out there’ like items on a shelf; they’re still true, but you cannot experience their effects in your life!

(cf. Romans 10:9 - “Confess with your mouth, AND believe in your heart!”)

The prophets of old had to internalize the truths of God; we already have the internal, indwelling presence of the God of all creation! He inhabits us and desires to fill us and control us in a way Habakkuk could never experience!

- Read psalms of His greatness (start with Psalm 18 and Psalm 77)
- Worship Him with songs of praise
