	a.	He us (4:13) He exchanges our weakness and inability for His strength and ability (Isa. 40:31) (And He gives us a forbearing spirit! Phil. 4:5)
	b.	He in all situations (4:11-12)
2.	Don't Focus on (Phil. 4:10-12)	
	a.	Circumstances aren't a measure of your (4:10) Many NT churches were poor! (Phil. 4:10; 2 Cor. 8:1-5) Jesus's own disciples where often in difficult circumstances (1 Cor. 4:11-13) Wealth and luxurious possessions are never mentioned as attributes of "spiritua leaders" (We never need to be anxious about material things! Phil. 4:6)
	b.	Circumstances aren't a measure of your (4:11-12) Don't judge yourself for not being perfect!

Application: Contentment comes from a learning process (4:11-12)

Difficult times *might* be maturing you.

Paul didn't aim for contentment; he aimed for Christ, and found contentment.
