"Israel" - the Northern Tribes (930-722 BC)

19 Kings, 9 Dynasties (0 Good Kings)

Jeroboam's Golden Calves / Samaria

"Judah" - the Southern Tribes (930-605/586 BC)

20 Kings, 1 Dynasty (7 Good Kings)

Solomon's Temple in Jerusalem

Exile (605-536 BC)

"Israel" destroyed by Assyria (722 BC)

"Judah" destroyed by Babylon (586 BC)

Captives taken to Babylon (605-586 BC)

(Rack, Shack, Benny; Daniel; Ezekiel)

Post-Exile (536-400 BC)

Walls of Jerusalem Rebuilt

City of Jerusalem Rebuilt

Temple Rebuilt

Inter-Testamental Period (400 BC – AD 0)

An Example from the Divided Kingdom (1 Kings 22:1-40)
