2. \_\_\_\_\_: "\_\_\_\_\_ " = Sympathetic concern. Hebrews 4:15; Deut. 4:29-31; Psalm 78:38-39; Job 9:32-10:5 realized!  
(The Story of the Weeping Camel)

3. \_\_\_\_\_: "Long of Nose" (like a "long fuse" vs. a "short fuse" / "quick temper")

4. \_\_\_\_\_: "hesed" - great and everlasting covenant-keeping kindness and love  
Redeeming us from sin  
Preserving our life from death  
Quickening our spiritual life  
Keeping His covenant with us  
"He condescends to the needs of His creatures; He willingly lowers Himself to our level."
