# FILLED

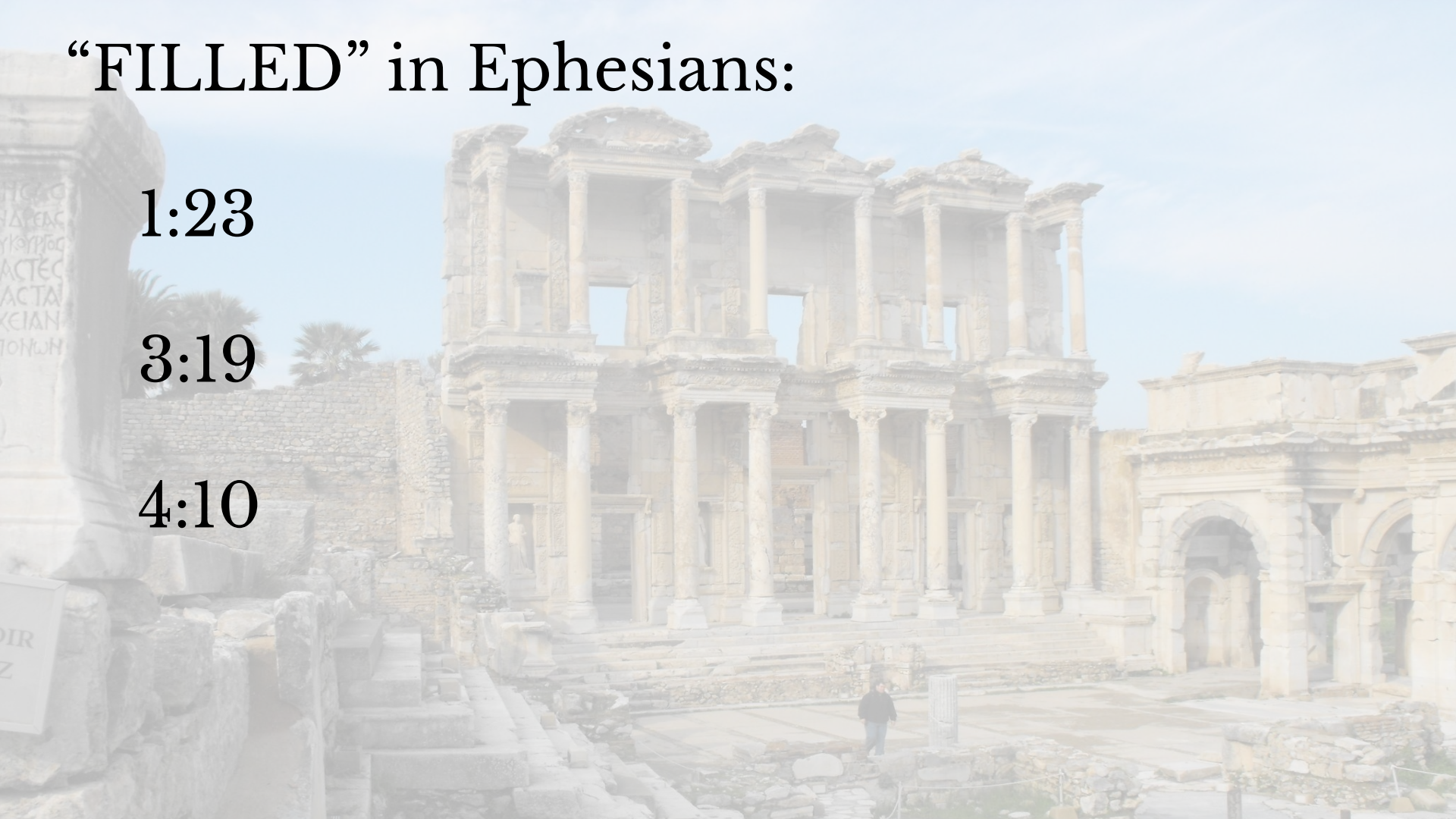
