






Built In Christ Jesus:


First Statement: "With all humility..."

2 Submission to <u>Christ</u> is necessary to be a believing <u>Church</u> (Eph. 1:22)

All things are subject to Him

"Subject" same word in 1:22 and 5:21

2 Submission to <u>Christ</u> is necessary to be a believing <u>Church</u> (Eph. 1:22)

He is the head of the Church

"Head" same word in 1:22 and 5:23

2 Submission to <u>Christ</u> is necessary to be a believing <u>Church</u> (Eph. 1:22)

Illus.: Our worship of Christ should be the *opposite* of what the Roman soldiers did to Christ

The "re-ordering" in Eph. 2:11-22 may have put all "ordered relationships" in question

The Scriptures are clarifying that structured relationships still exist

This "submitting" isn't all in relationships of Lord-Master / Subject-Servant

1 Peter 5:1-7

This "submitting" is based on "fear" of Christ "reverence" for Christ "Humble devotion" to Christ "recognition of HIS superiority"
