Washington moves his army north. By January 6th, they arrive in Morristown for winter encampment.

Washington crosses the Delaware River on Christmas night, December 25, 1776

On January 2, Cornwallis moves his army to meet Washington in Trenton.

After discovering that Washington has moved to Princeton, Cornwallis resteps his command back to Princeton.

After the Battle of Assunpink Creek, Washington moves his army to Princeton.

On December 30, Washington recrossed the Delaware River and set up defensive line on the south side of the Assunpink Creek.

After the Battle of Trenton, Washington recrosses the Delaware River.


