

You need not bring life to the Scripture; you shall draw life from the Scripture. Brothers and sisters, let us greatly reverence the Word of God. If it be all this, let us read it, study it, and prize it. And you that are not converted, I do pray you treat the Bible with a holy love and reverence, and read it with the view of finding Christ and his salvation in it. Dear friends, whenever we feel ourselves dead, and especially in prayer, get close to the Word, for the Word of God is alive. When you have nothing to say to your God, let him say something to you. Whenever we feel weak in our duties, let us go to the Word of God, and the Christ in the word, for power; and this will be the best of power. The power of our natural abilities, the power of our acquired knowledge, the power of our gathered experience, all these may be vanity, but the power which is in the Word will prove effectual. Get thou up from the cistern of thy failing strength to the fountain of omnipotence; for they that drink here, while the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall, shall run, and not be weary, and shall walk, and not faint.
