







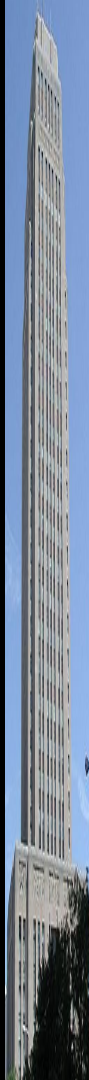

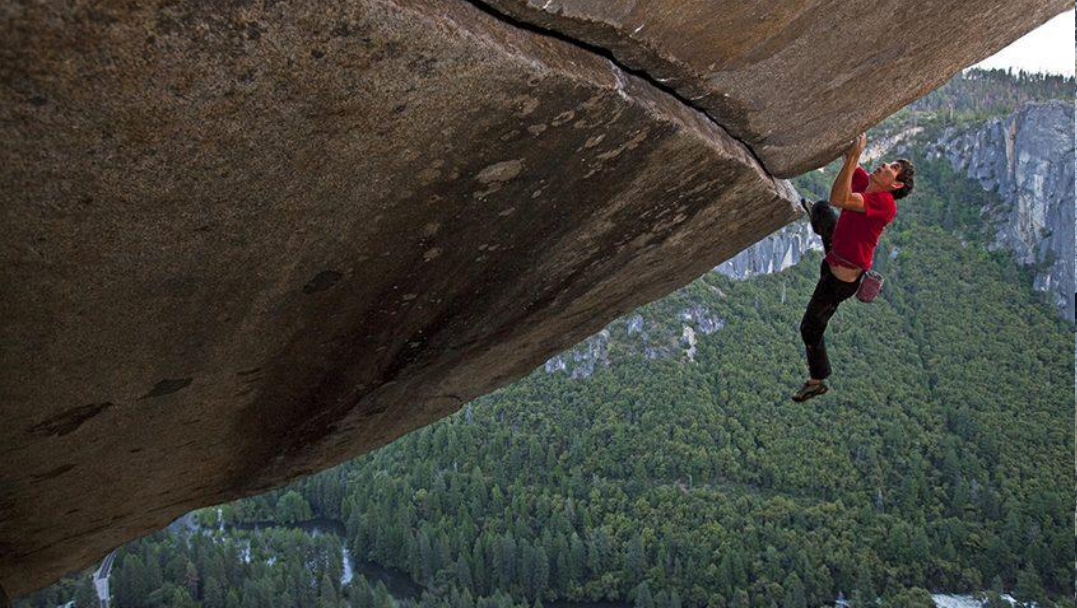

Delivered FROM disease TO health

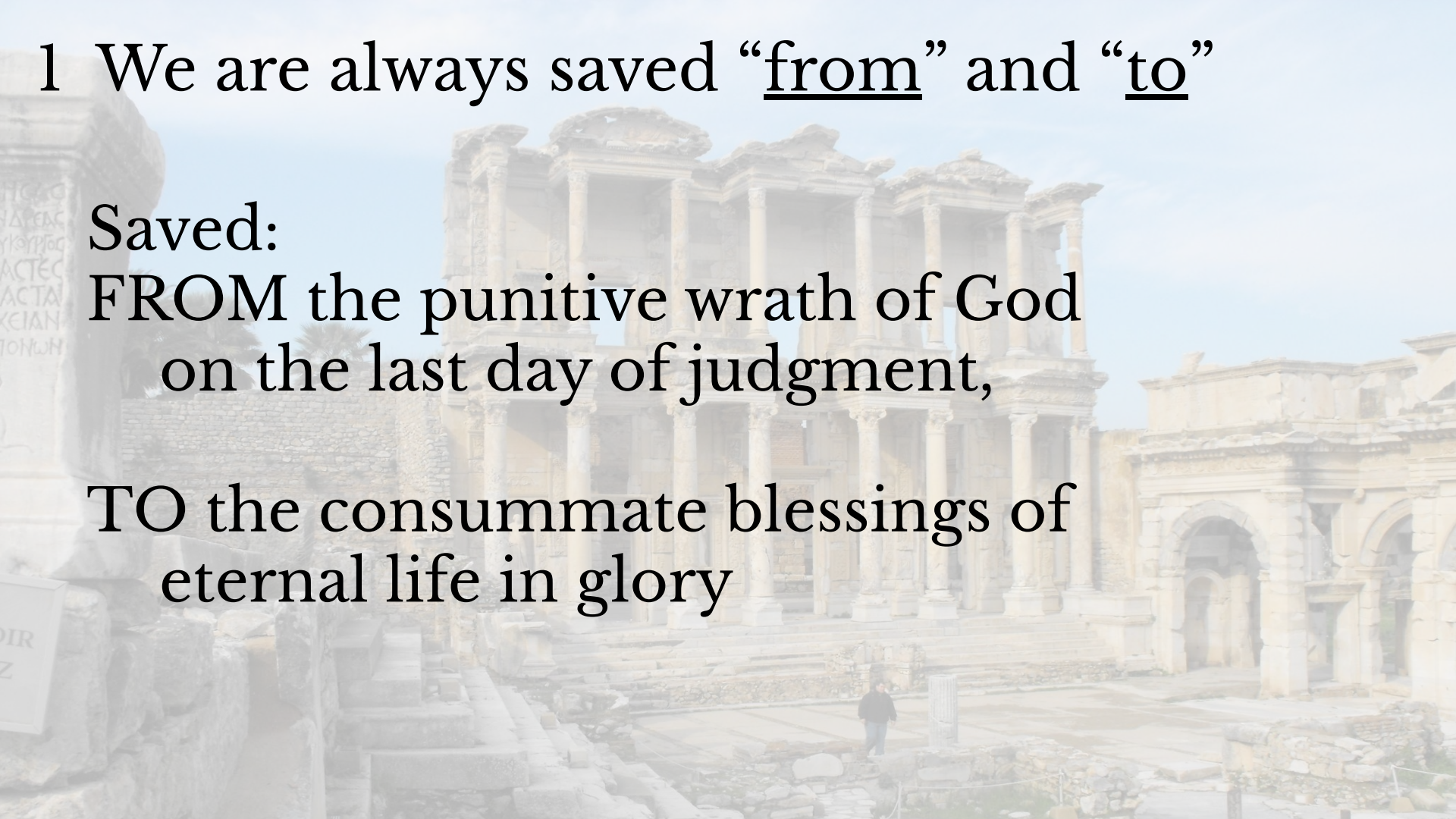
